The History and Legend of the Zolotonosha Distillery

In 1896, the Zolotonosha Distillery was founded in Zolotonosha, Cherkasy Region of Ukraine. The local soil is rich in precious metals and there are a number of spring-fed natural wells, which are acknowledged as curative by scientists and the Institute of Ecology and Toxicology. This is believed to be very favorable for the production of high quality spirituous beverages. So, for over 100 years, the Zlatogor experts have developed a huge archive of recipes for alcoholic beverages utilizing the spring water and infusing the curative herbs.

The city of Zolotonosha lies on the banks of the Zolotonosha River. History reveals that in the 17th century, there was the Castle of Yarema Vishnevetsky, where all of the taxes, collected from the numerous estates, were stored. This may be the reason that the city is named Zolotonosha, which means "bringing gold". However, according to scientists, the city owes its name to the river. The soil is rich in precious metals, and the elements in the sand around Zolotonosha have a sheen. The sand in the bottom of the river shines like gold, making it one of the most beautiful areas in the world.
